### Summary

Ultimate AppendIT is a file management tool that utilizes the familiar power of Windows to make it easy to find, link, and use your data anywhere on your network. The storage files can be created directly from QuickBooks, and you may access all your linked data from a QuickBooks pull down menu.

### Strengths

Ultimate AppendIT can be set up in 15 minutes and is easy to understand and use. You can name your file structures to correspond with names utilized in QuickBooks, which would keep your naming conventions consistent. You can access any file stored in the AppendIT directory directly from the QuickBooks pull down menu.

### Limitations

There were none. Limitations are centered on the version of Ultimate AppendIT that is purchased. The various versions will determine how many different areas Ultimate AppendIT syncs up with QuickBooks.

### Wish List

Product is very easy to use. The company needs to do a better job of telling me why I should buy this product rather than create my own file directories and access them through a short cut on my desktop. The developers website does not do a good job of telling the story about this product and its strengths.

The company does not have a published privacy policy, but they informed me that the plug-in does not utilize any of the user's personal or sensitive information.</p>	7.0

You may utilize the same e-mail address to install Ultimate AppendIT on various desktops. There must be one copy of AppendIT for each installed copy of QuickBooks. ## Ratings Definitions
